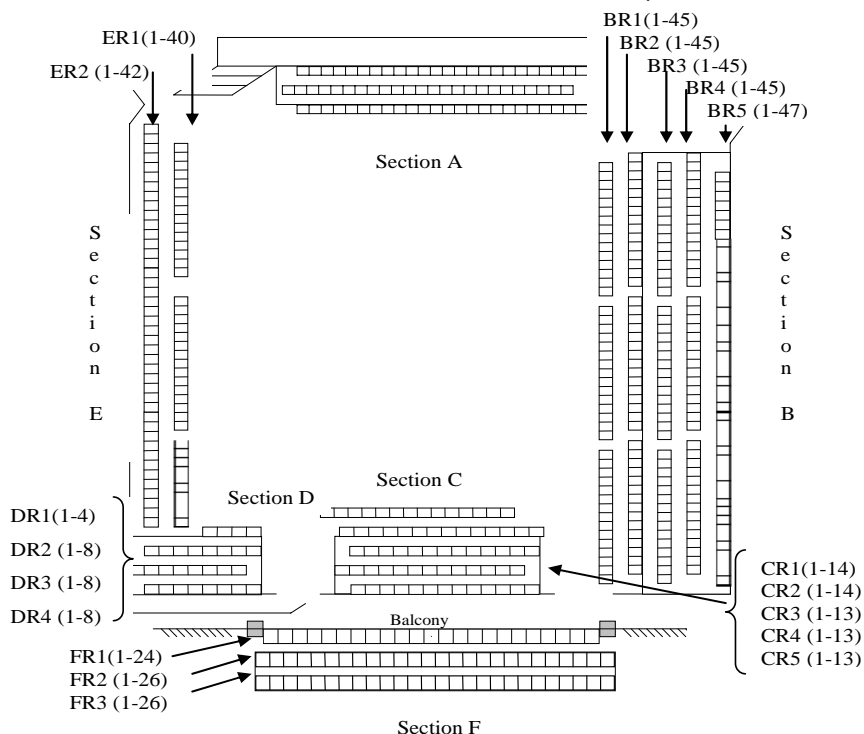

GENERAL RULES (Full details on Entry Forms)

- All competitors must present their valid DSAB, CADA or IDSF affiliate membership card when obtaining competition #'s.
- In all championships a minimum of three (3) couples are required to hold the championship. In all other competitions (2) couples are required.
- Both Youth and Senior couples may also compete in Adult competitions.
- NORTHERN LIGHTS CLASSIC NON-CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS: Dress code is according to DSAB schedule G. See: www.dancesport Alberta.org
- CHAMPIONSHIPS: Competition dress is obligatory. See: www.dancesport.ca
 - Standard - Men: Black or dark blue tails, white shirt and white tie.
 - Standard - Ladies: Competition dress.
 - Latin - Men: Latin costume with sleeves
 - Latin - Ladies: Latin costume for ladies.
- **All competitors must be ready 1 hour before their event and present themselves for costume check.** In case of tardiness, the competition will not be delayed.
- All competitions require Full Day Admission Tickets (There are no additional competition entry fees for amateur competitors)

Age Classification for 2009:

A. Competition Age Classification determined by the age of the oldest partner

JUVENILE: (Juvenile I & II will be combined in this Event)

Juvenile I - Reached their 9th birthday or less in the calendar year. Born in 2000 or later (2000, 2001 etc.)

Juvenile II - Reached their 10th or 11th birthday in the calendar year. Born in 1999 or 1998

JUNIOR: (Junior I & II will be combined in this Event)

Junior I - Reached their 12th or 13th birthday in the calendar year. Born in 1997 or 1996

Junior II - Reached their 14th or 15th birthday in the calendar year. Born in 1995 or 1994

YOUTH: Reached their 16th, 17th, or 18th birthday in the calendar year. Born in 1993, 1992 or 1991

ADULT: 1st partner has reached their 19th birthday or more in the calendar year (born in 1989 or earlier) and the 2nd partner has reached their 14th birthday or more in the calendar year (1995 or earlier)

B. Competition Age Classification determined by both partners

SENIOR:

Senior I - Both partners have reached their thirty-fifth (35th) birthday or more in the calendar year. Both born in 1974 or earlier

Senior II - Both partners have reached their forty-fifth (45th) birthday or more in the calendar year. Both born in 1964 or earlier
